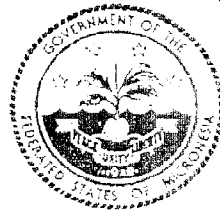

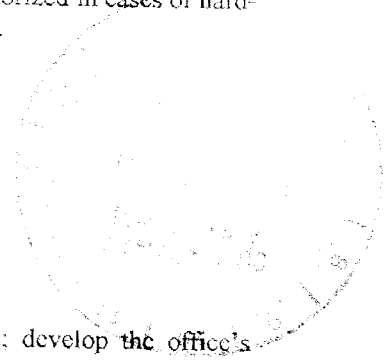
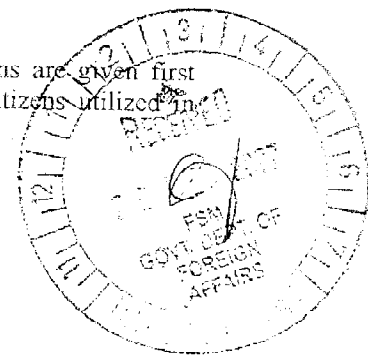

QUALIFICATION REQUIRMENTS:

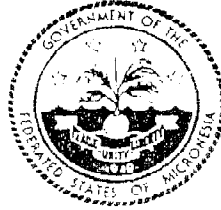

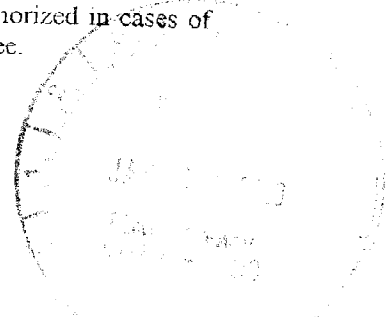
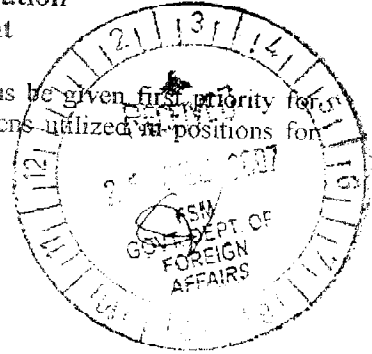
