

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FSM CITIZENS APPLYING FOR REPLACEMENT I-94 CARD APPLICATION FORM I-102

Revised 9/2007

(NOTICE: The US Citizenship and Immigration Services (CIS) has increased the FEE for Replacement I-94 Card to \$320.00 effective July 30, 2007.)

This is a summary of instructions provided to help FSM Citizens when applying for a replacement I-94 Card. More detail information on Instructions is available on the FSM Embassy website (www.fsmembassydc.org) or can be found on US Citizenship and Immigration Services website (www.uscis.gov).

All FSM citizens need to apply for a replacement I-94 card if their original I-94s have been lost, damaged or issued incorrectly. It is important that the information on your I-94 card must match the information on your Passport.

Instructions for filling out application for Replacement I-94(also known as I-102 form):

- 1.) Completely fill out both pages of the application form. All FSM Citizens enter USA under the Compact of Free Association as "CFA/FSM". No visa is required and the "CFA/FSM" entry status does not expire.
- 2.) Attach US Postal Money Order in the amount of **\$320.00** for processing fee of your application.
- 3.) Attach a copy of your FSM Passport and a copy of your I-94 if you have a copy.
- 4.) Processing of FSM citizens applications is centralized. Please send your application to:

Before mailing, ensure that your application is completely filled out, signed AND supporting documents and money order are enclosed.
